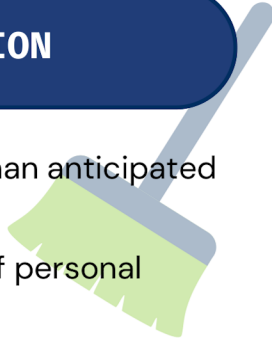


Vacate Cleaning Checklist

PREPARATION

- Allocate more time than anticipated for cleaning.
- Clear out the home of personal belongings.
- Gather cleaning supplies: mop, bucket, steam cleaner, vacuum cleaner, rubber gloves, duster, glass cleaner, oven cleaner, and other cleaning products.



GENERAL

- Dust and vacuum all rooms top to bottom.
- Clean walls, floors, and upholstery.
- Spot clean walls for scuff marks using a gentle cleaning solution.
- Vacuum carpets and clean window and door tracks.

KITCHEN

- Clean the tops of cabinets and the refrigerator.
- Clean inside and outside all drawers and cupboards.
- Deep clean the oven, stove, microwave, and other appliances.
- Clean countertops, sinks, taps, and tiles.
- Wipe down the range hood exhaust and filter.



BATHROOM

- Thoroughly clean the toilet, bathtub, shower, and sink.
- Address soap scum, limescale, and mildew on tiles and glass surfaces.
- Clean mirrors, exhaust fans, and high-touch areas.



Vacate Cleaning Checklist

LIVING ROOM

- Vacuum carpets and upholstery.
- Clean storage units like wardrobes and drawers.
- Dust and clean window frames, blinds, and sills.
- Spot clean walls and baseboards.

BEDROOMS

- Vacuum carpets and upholstery.
- Clean storage units like wardrobes and drawers.
- Dust and clean window frames, blinds, and sills.
- Spot clean walls and baseboards.

OUTDOOR AREAS

- Tend to the garden by mowing and weeding.
- Clean outdoor furniture and fixtures.
- Wash entryways, driveways, and pathways.
- Clean the garage, including walls, floors, and storage units.

FINAL TOUCHES

- Vacuum the entire house to remove any last traces of dust and debris.
- Ensure all areas are free of personal items and rubbish.

FINAL CHECK

- Check all rooms for missed spots
- Ensure that all trash has been removed from the premises
- Confirm that all appliances and fixtures are in their original place
